Baby Puppy In Show

Bitch **No.47 BEECEE CHERRY BLOSSOM (AI)**

Very good expression for the baby puppy. Needs a little bit more show training, this dog has very good balance and the owner can look forward to an enjoyable show future with this dog.



Minor Puppy In Show

Bitch **No.35 BORDACROFT TOUCHED BY AN ANGEL**

Very good balance, composition and muscle is very good for a minor puppy, movement is very good for her age, very good body condition and coat and good temperament, very nice bitch.

The size and balance and front and rear angulation are good, expression of the eyes is especially good when looking at the sheep. The combination with the handler excellent. The owner showed very well with great expression. Very nice dog.



Junior In Show

This bitch has very good condition, front and rear angulation is good. As a puppy she has very good construction and balance, may improve with more socialisation by the owner.

Has very good condition, rear and front good, nice muscle, movement was good, the owner encourages him to move very well, that is why he is in good condition. Very nice dog.

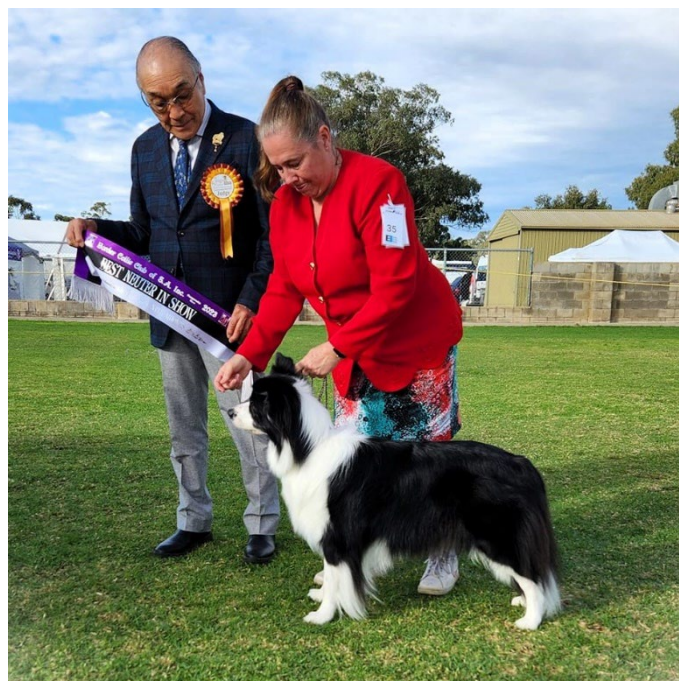


Neuter In Show
